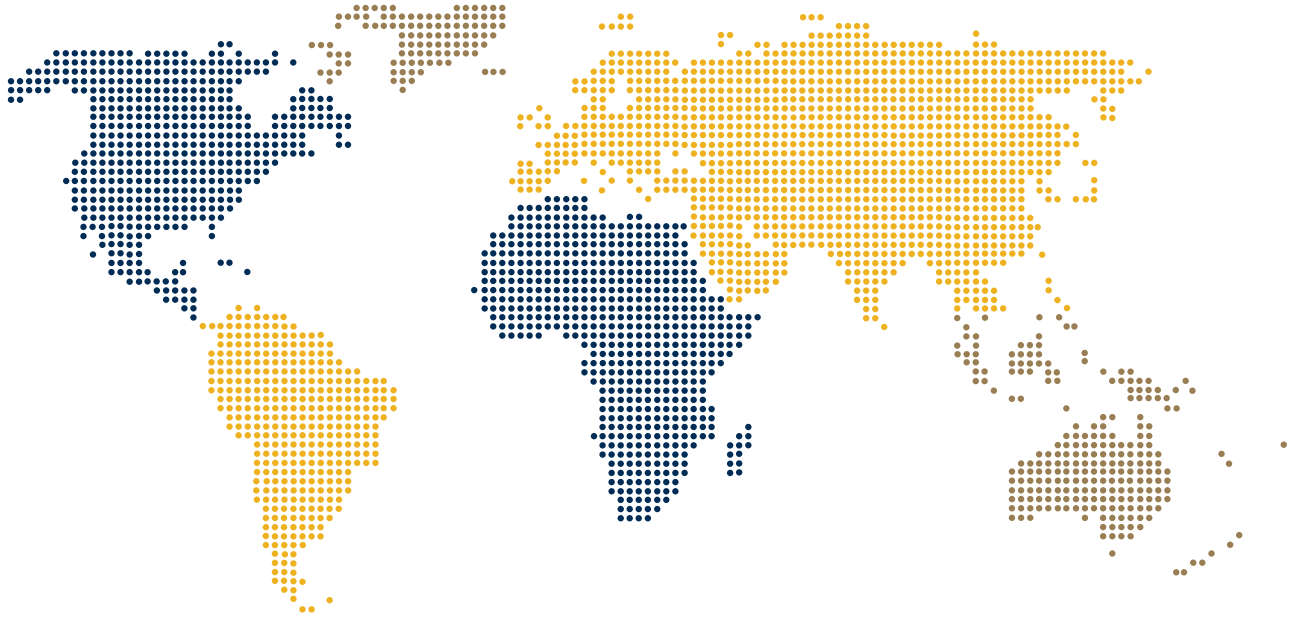

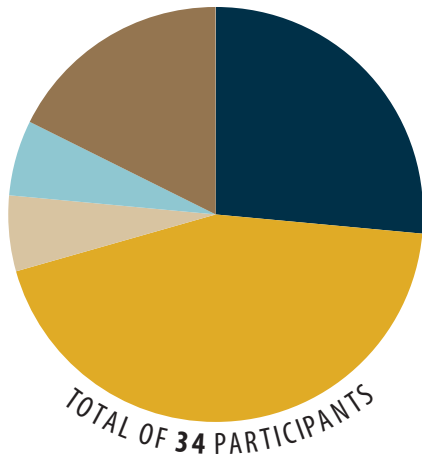

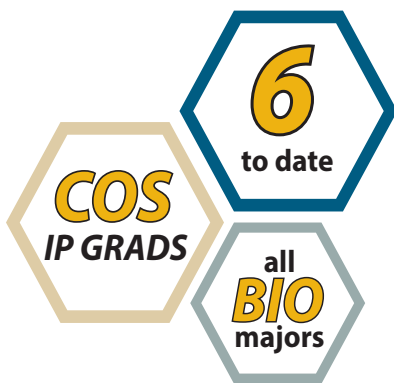

COS: Number of IP Participants, 2014-15



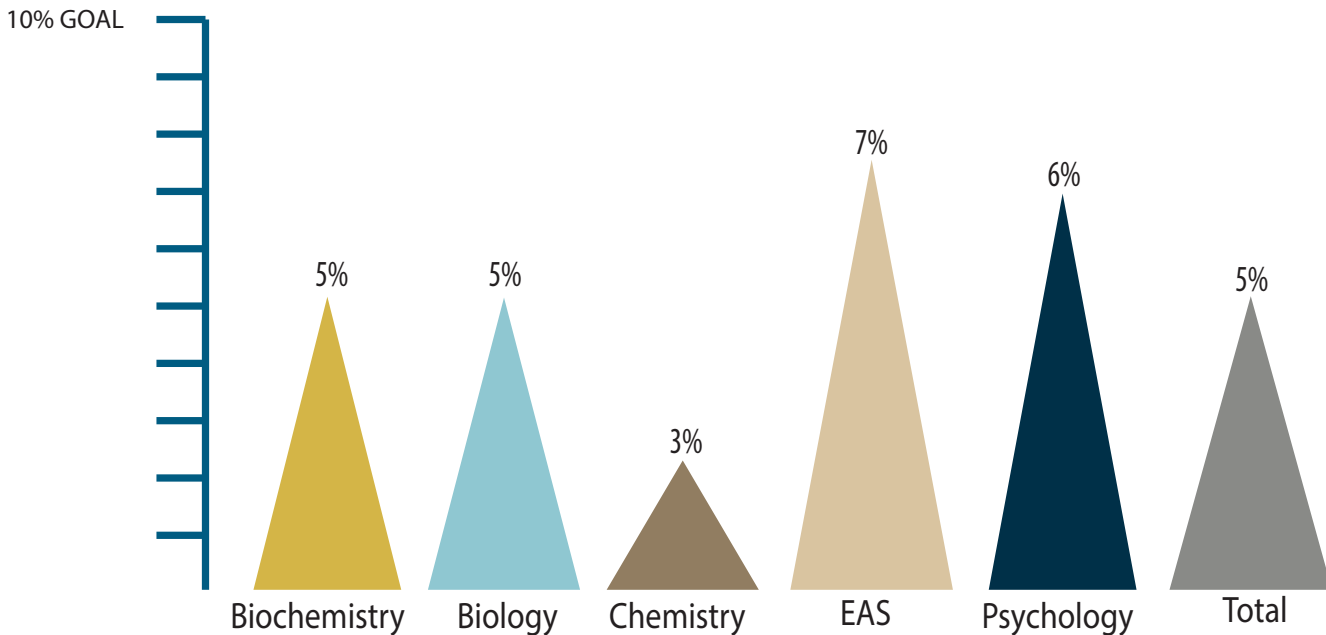

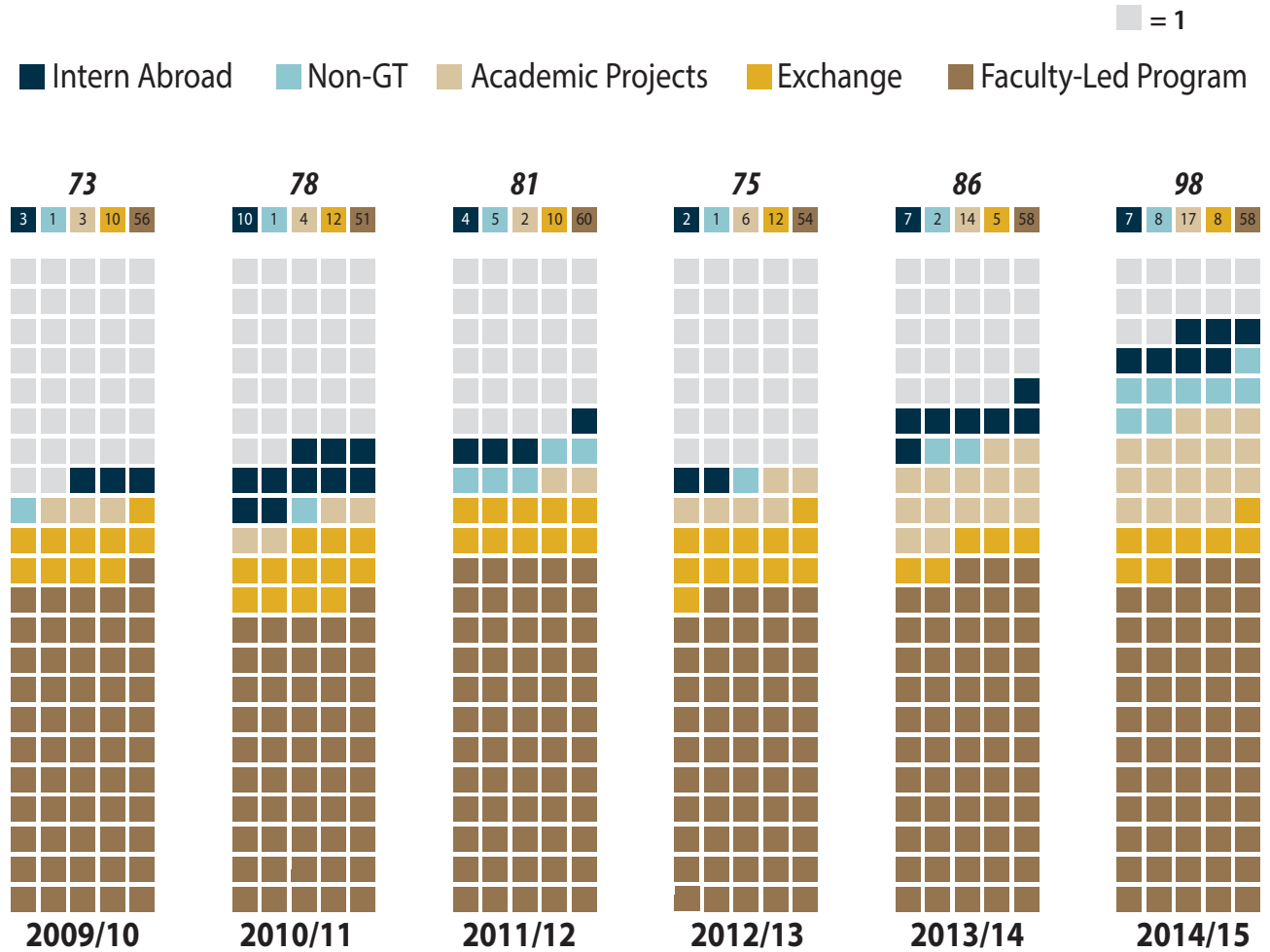

COS: Participants Abroad Over Time

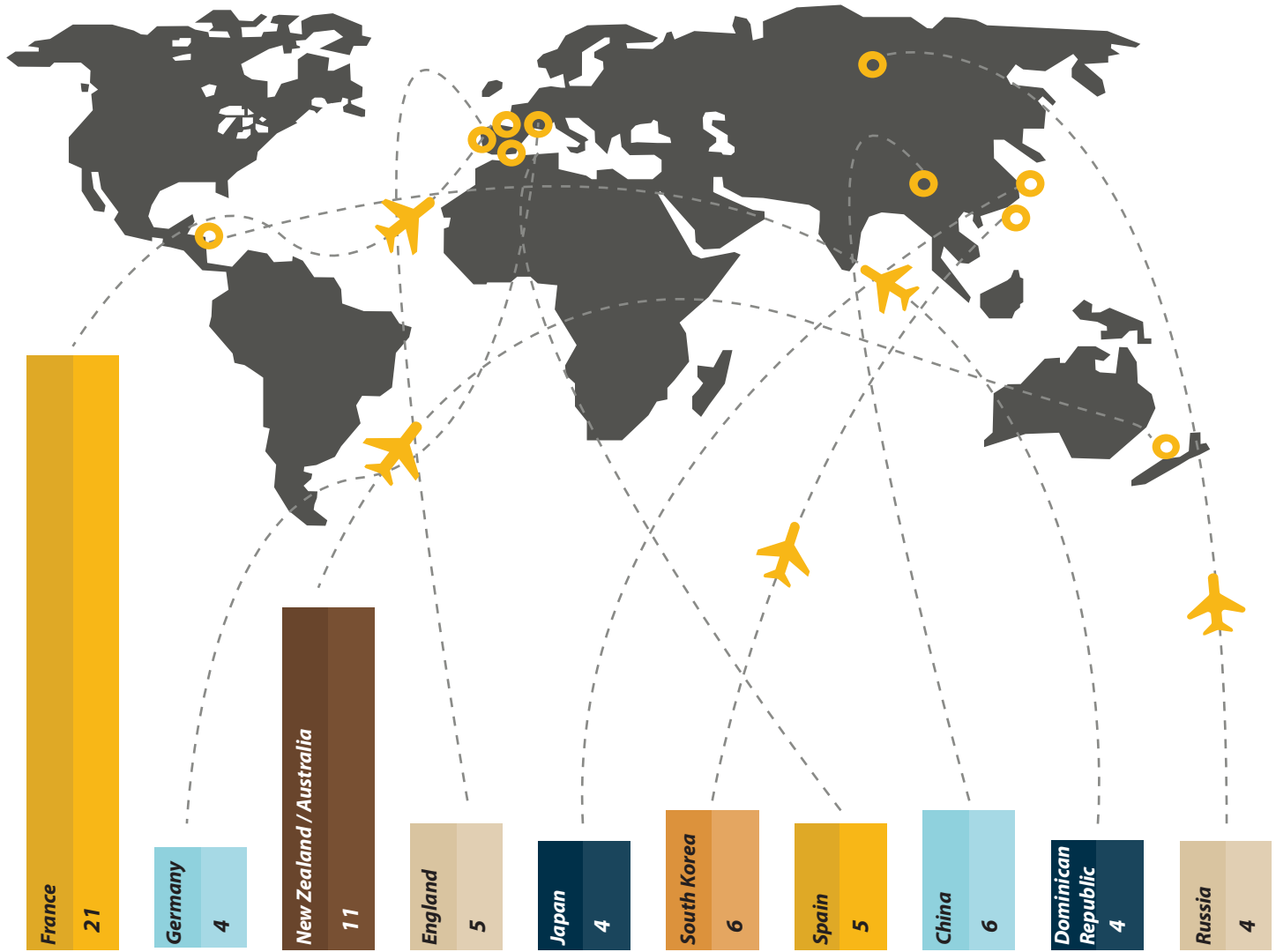

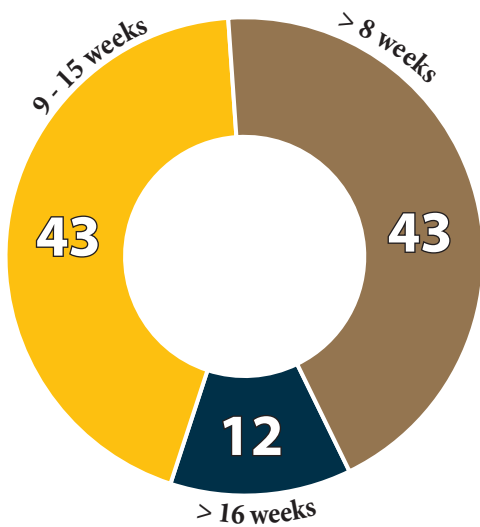

COS: Participants Abroad by Location, 2014-15*

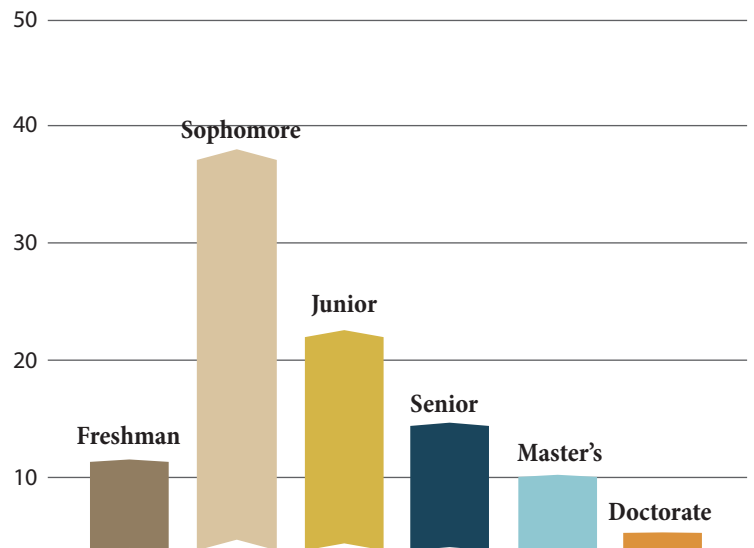

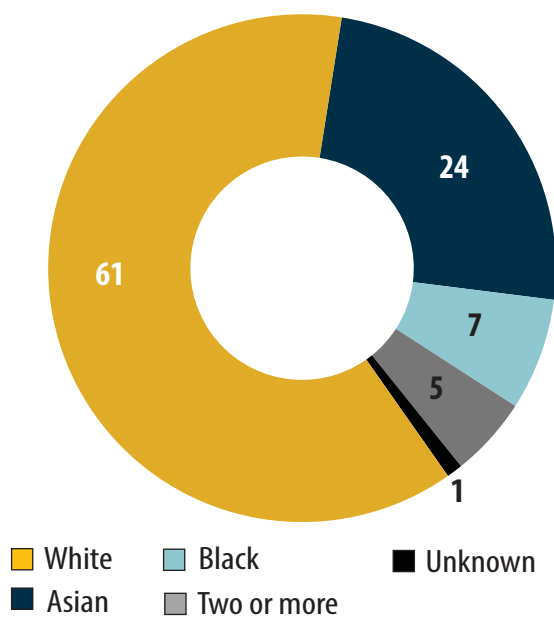

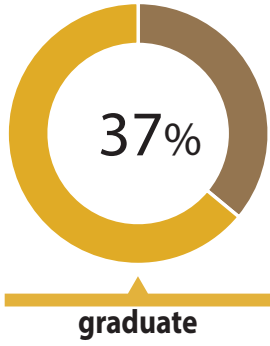

COS: Participants Abroad by Race, 2014-15

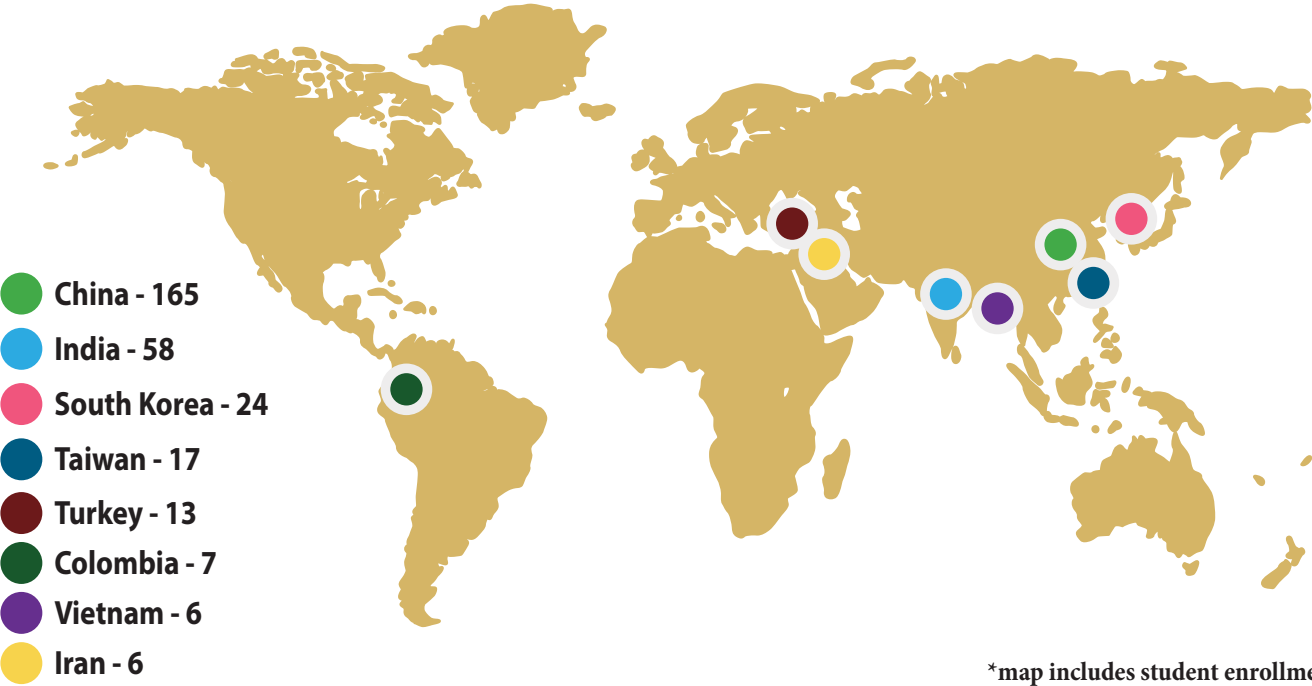


Percentage of enrolled COS students who are international

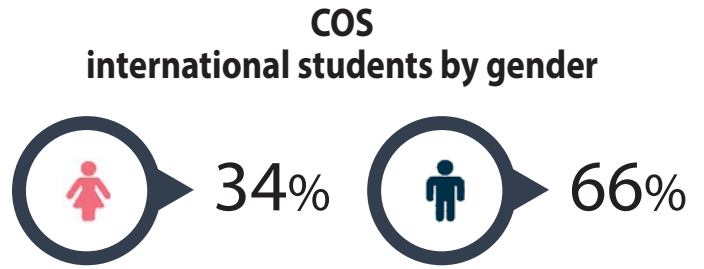
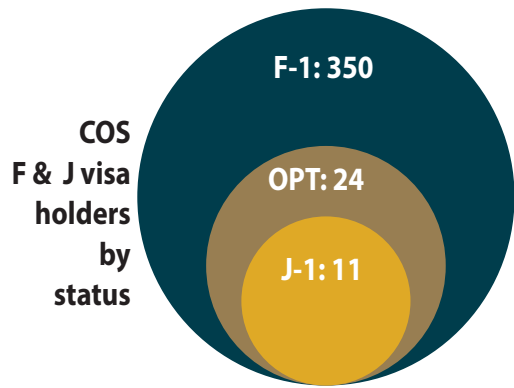


GT hosted 95 students this year who were awarded exchange fellowships by organizations such as Fulbright.
This year, COS hosted 3 exchange fellows.

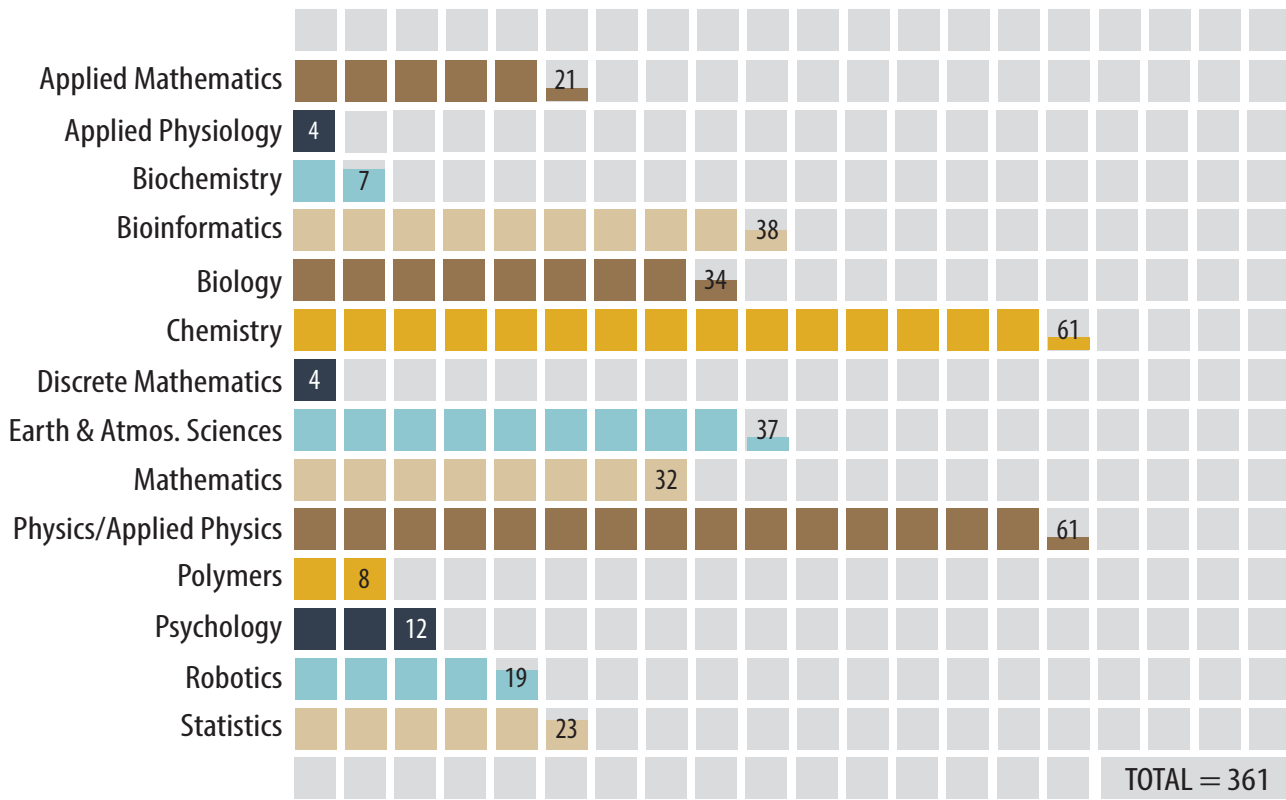
COS: International Student Citizenship (F & J Visa Holders), 2014-15*



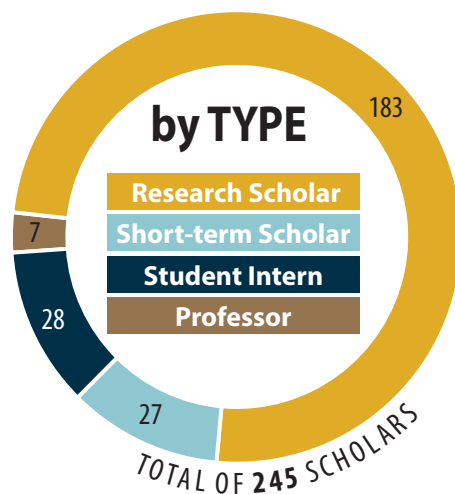
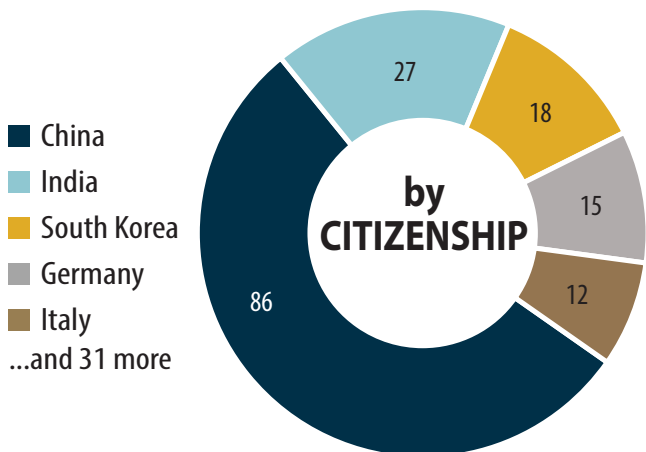
While the number of international students in COS decreased from last year, the number of scholars that the college hosted has increased more than 25%.

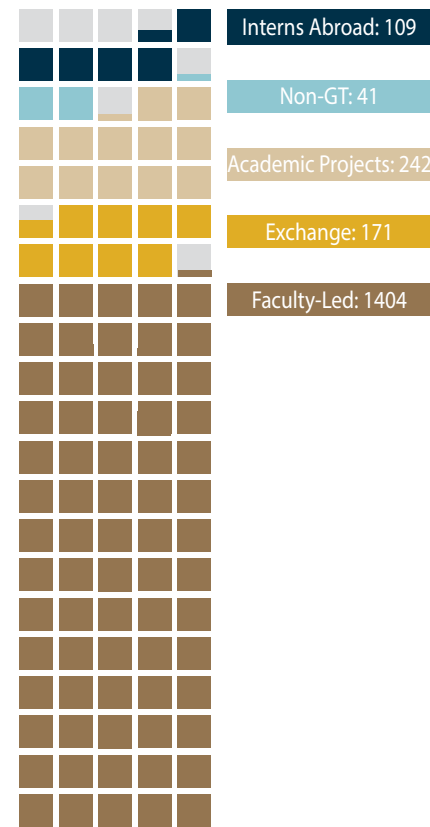

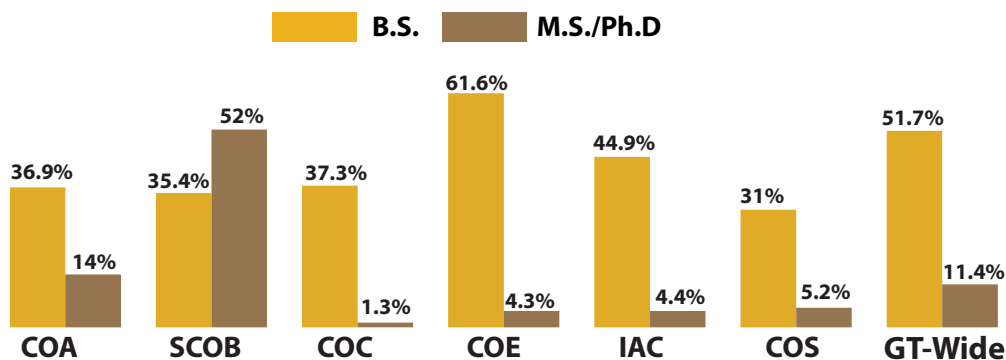


Participants abroad 2014-15 by program type

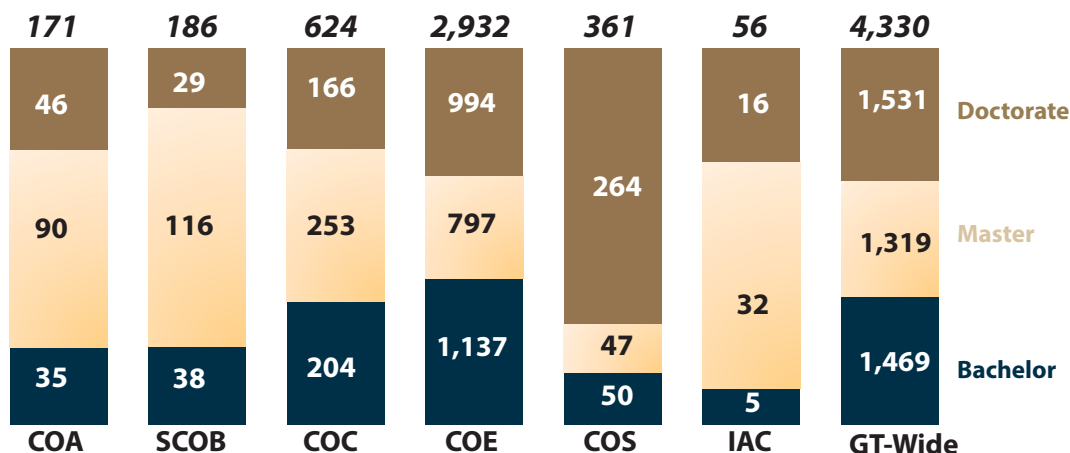
