

Growth in Georgia Tech undergraduate students' participation in programs abroad in the past five years.


Since 2010, the number of B.S. graduates with an international experience has grown to 1,967.


COS: Number of IP Participants, 2014-15



COS: IP Participation as a Percentage of Enrollment, by Major




COS: Participants Abroad Over Time







COS: Participants Abroad by Location, 2014-15*




COS: Participants Abroad by Length, 2014-15


COS: Participants Abroad by Level, 2014-15











COS: International Student Citizenship (F & J Visa Holders), 2014-15*
