

# GEORGIA TECH INTERNATIONAL ACTIVITY REPORT



With 4,301 international F-1 and J-1 students, GT ranks 28th for hosting international students (among doctorate-granting universities in the U.S.)

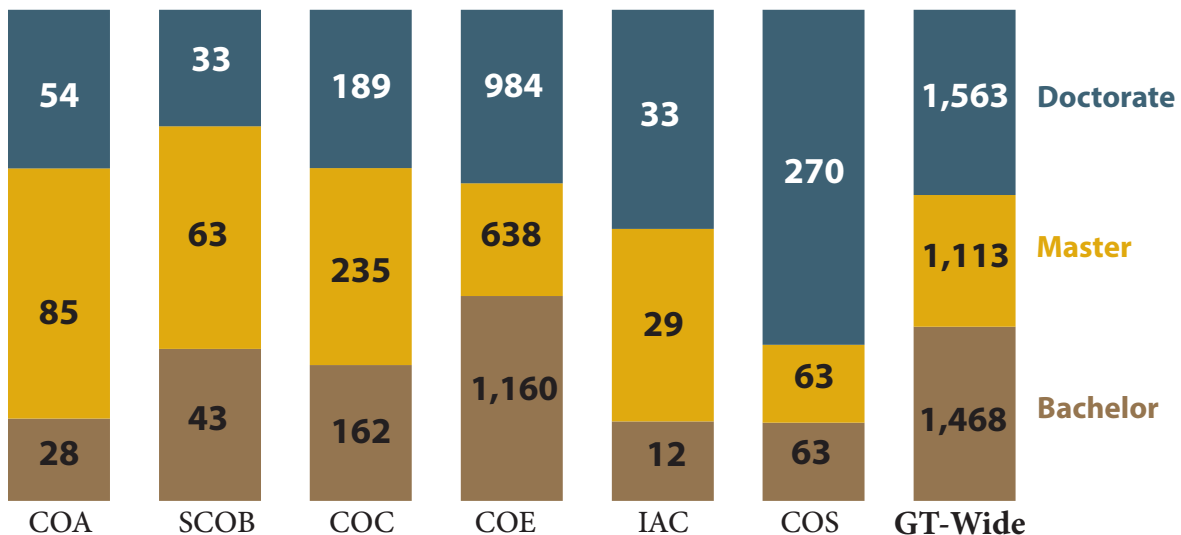
During 2013-14, the first year that GT participated in the J-1 intern program, GT hosted 97 student interns from 24 countries.

GT hosted 96 exchange fellows this year through programs like Fulbright.

International students at GT contribute over \$120 million to the local Atlanta-area economy.

GT ranks 35th for institutions hosting the largest number (almost 900) of J-1 international scholars.

48% of B.S. recipients study or intern abroad prior to graduation (increased 2%; the GT Strategic Plan goal is 60%).

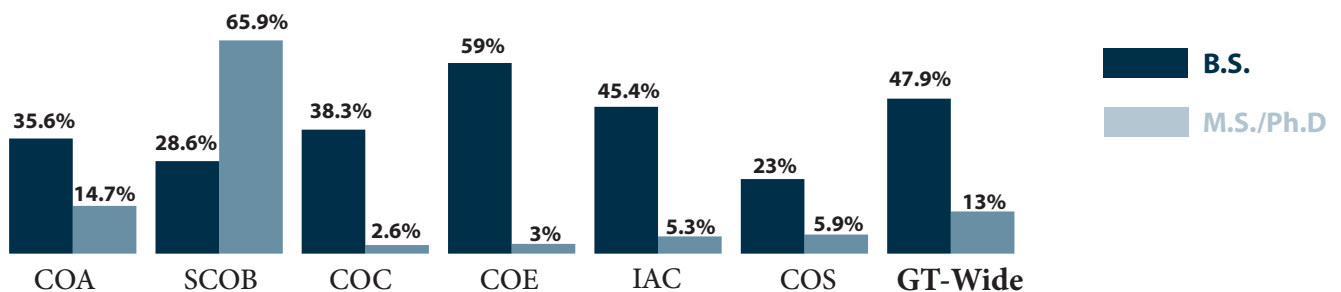
Students participated in 119 study abroad programs and interned for 110 international employers in 65 countries.

The number of students participating in international programs has increased by 42% in the past five years.

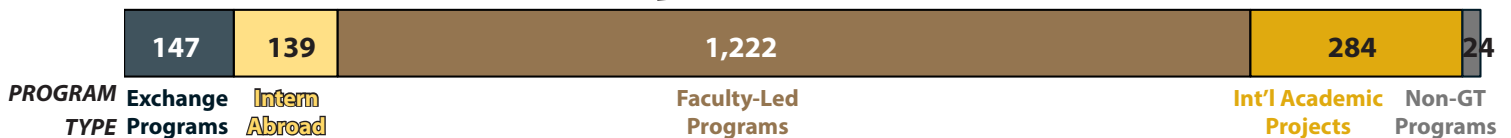
Over the past five years the 6-year graduation rate for students who studied abroad averaged 96.8% compared to a 75.1% graduation rate for students who did not study abroad.

The recently revamped Global Internship Program sends students abroad for corporate, research, non-profit and government internships.

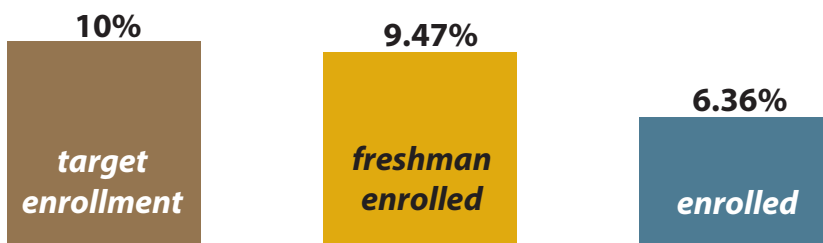
## Students Graduating with an Experience Abroad
