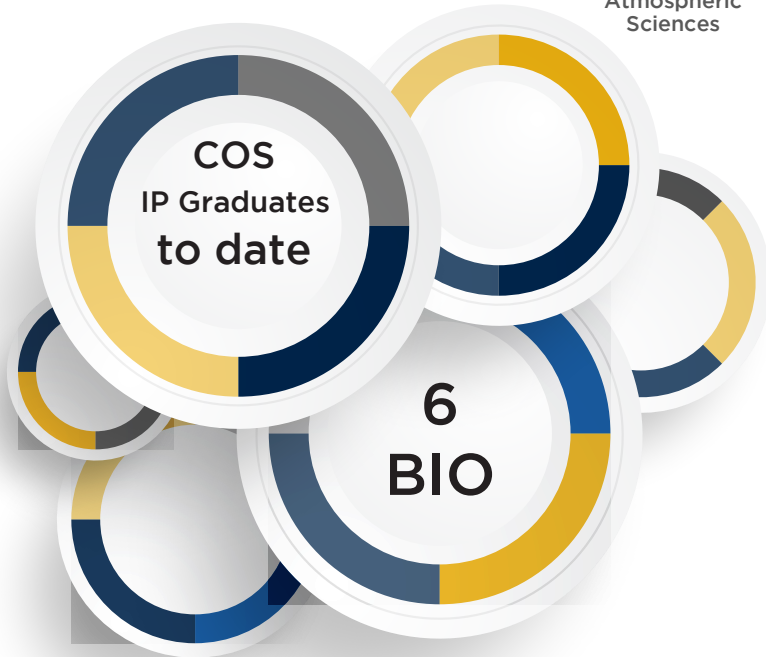
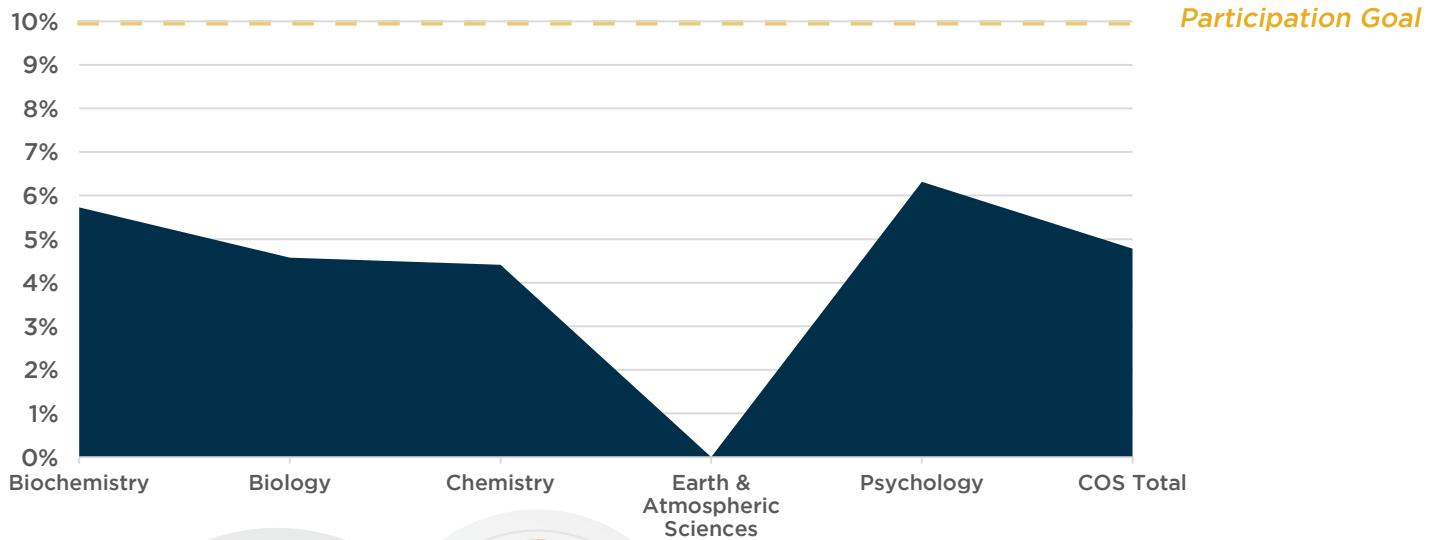

COS IP Participation as a Percentage of Enrollment

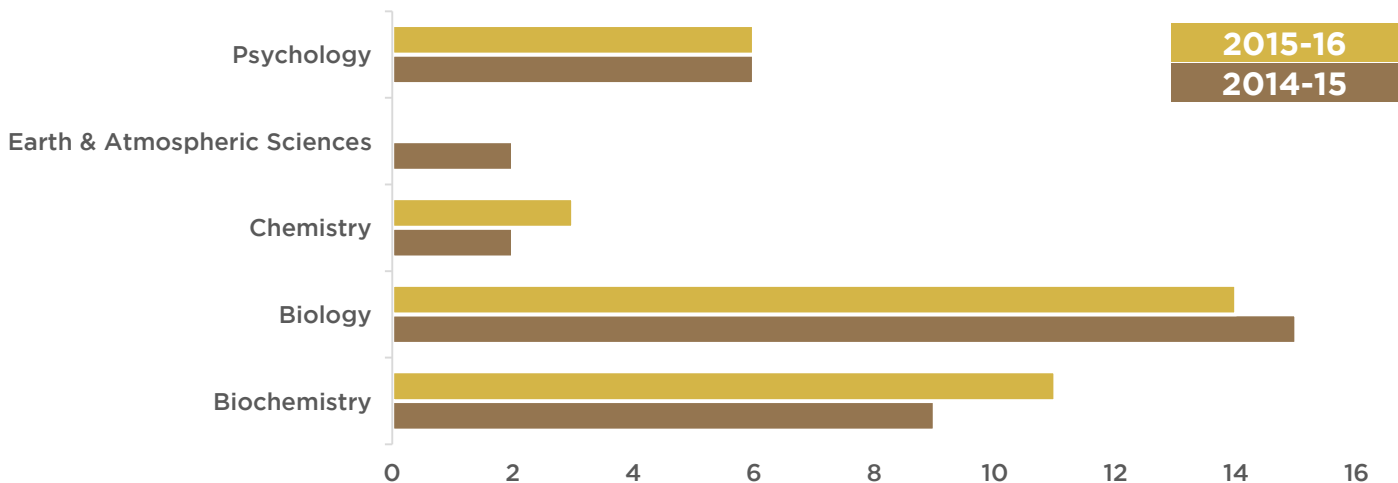

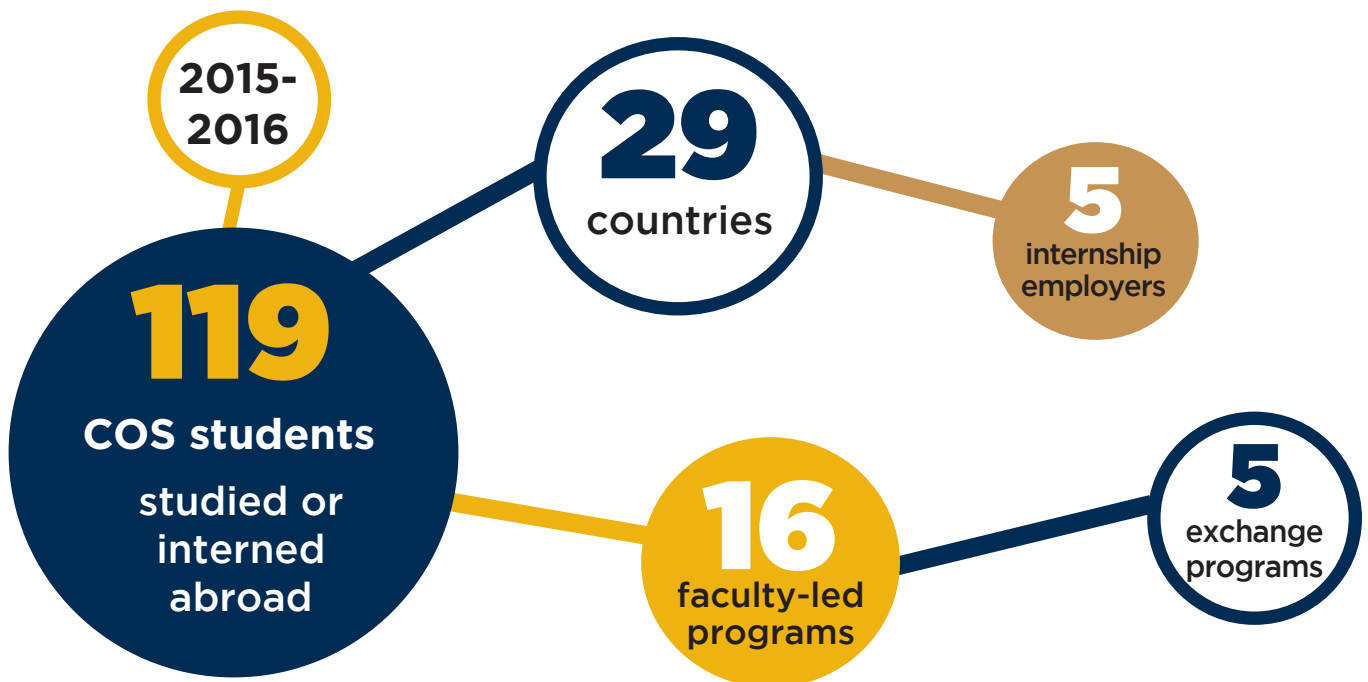

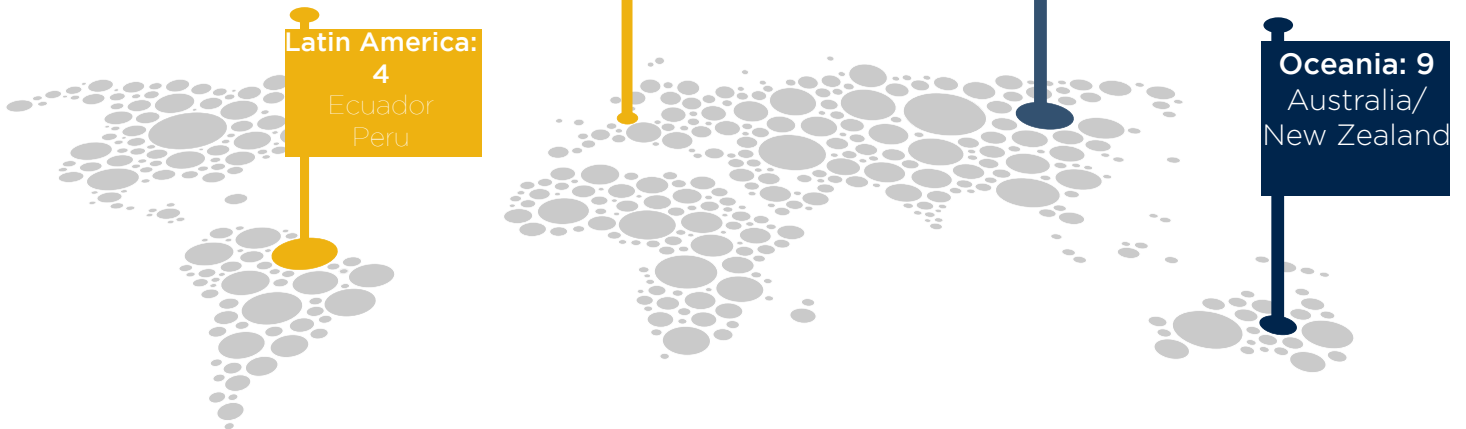

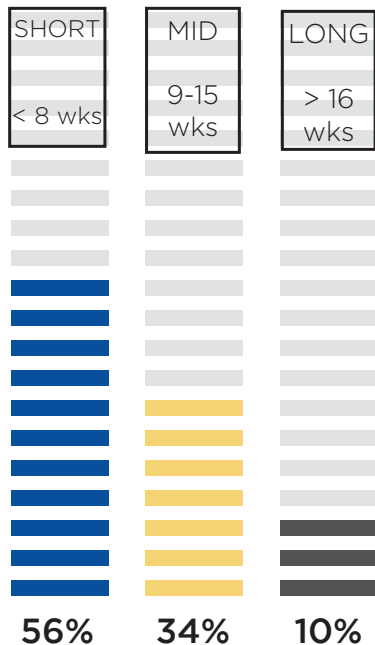




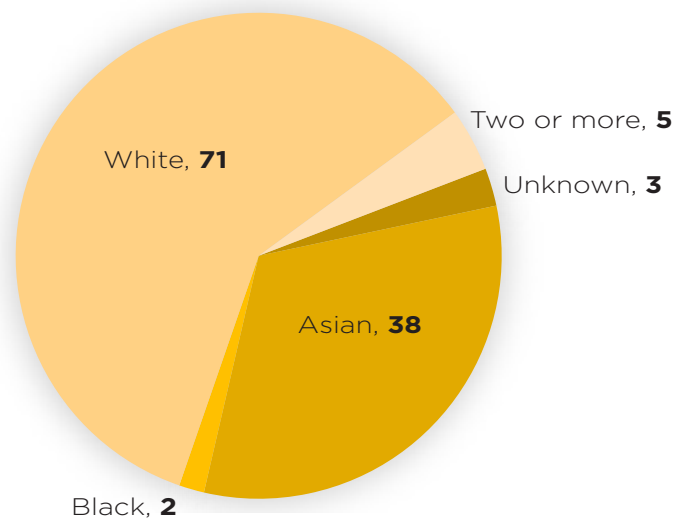
COS Participants Abroad by Region

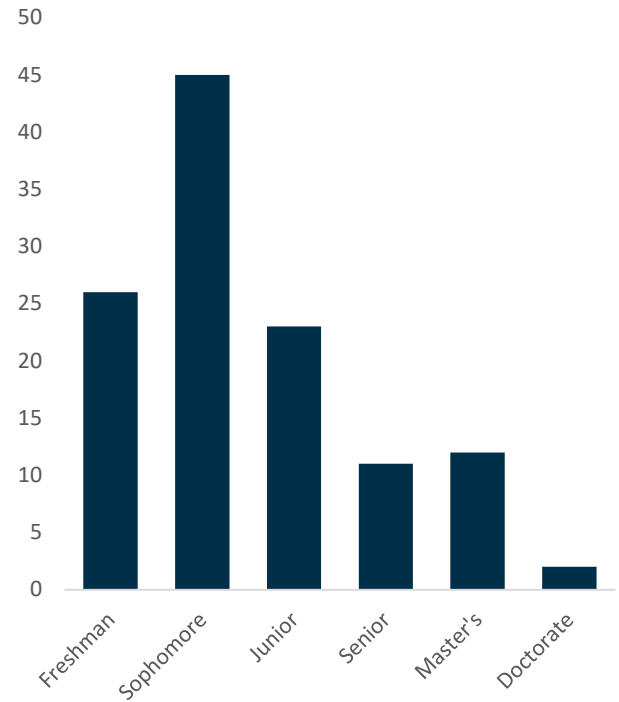

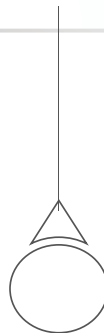

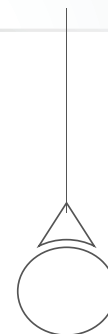

Percentage of COS students that studied or interned in France in 2015-16

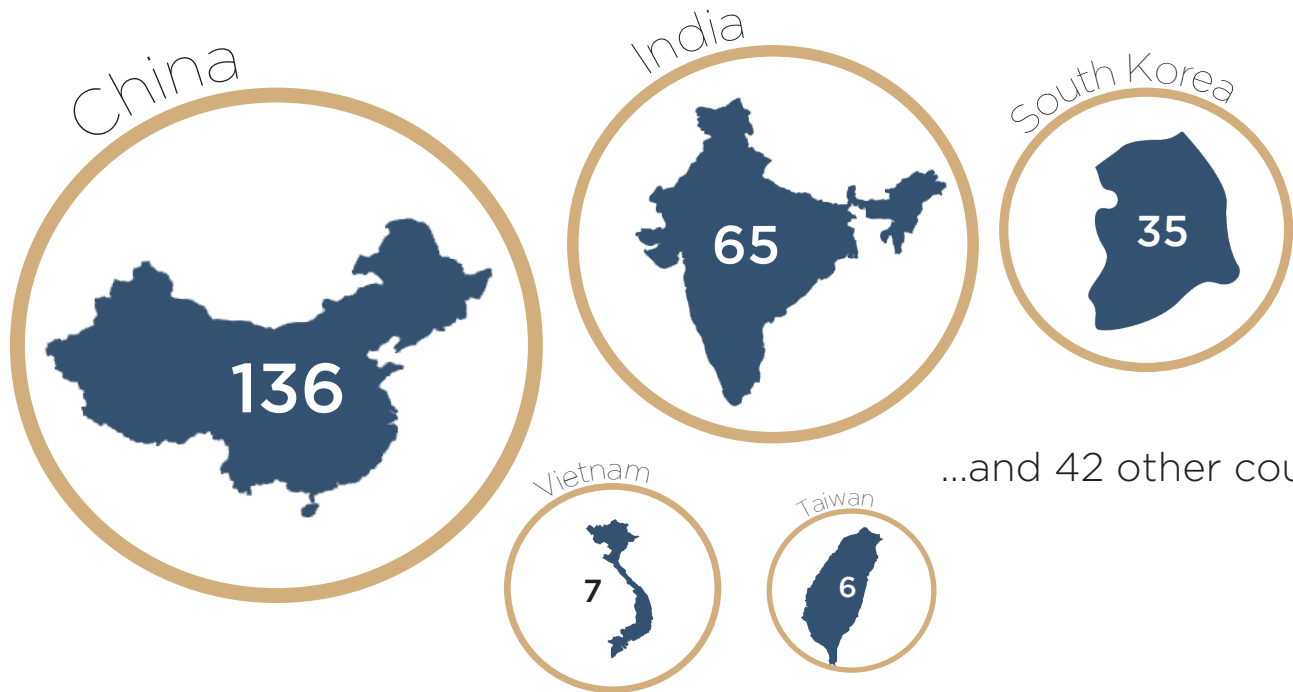

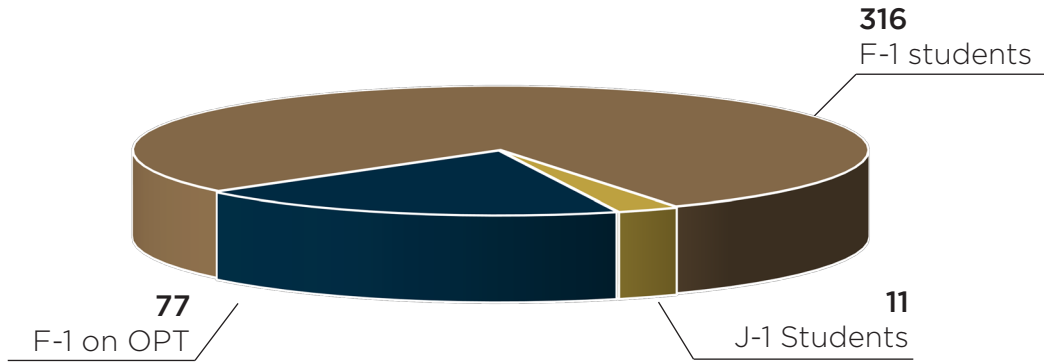

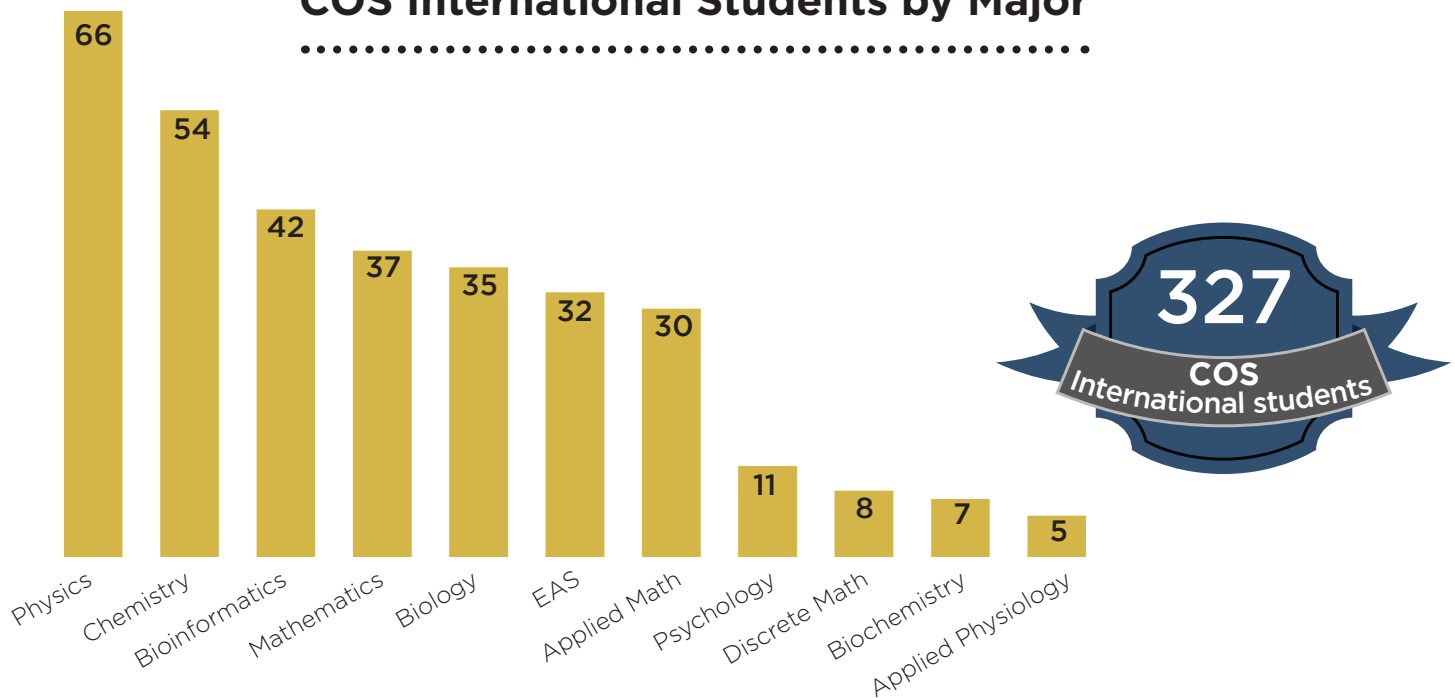




COS International Students by Type

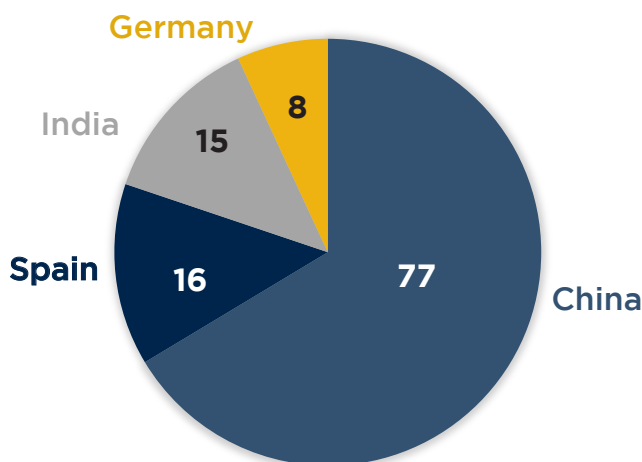


COS International Students by Major



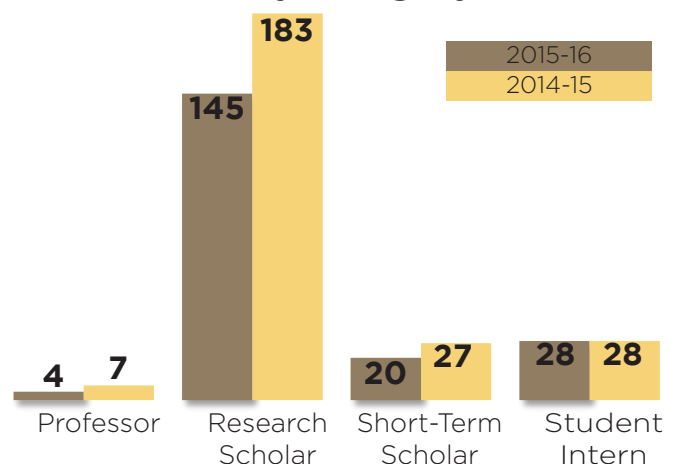

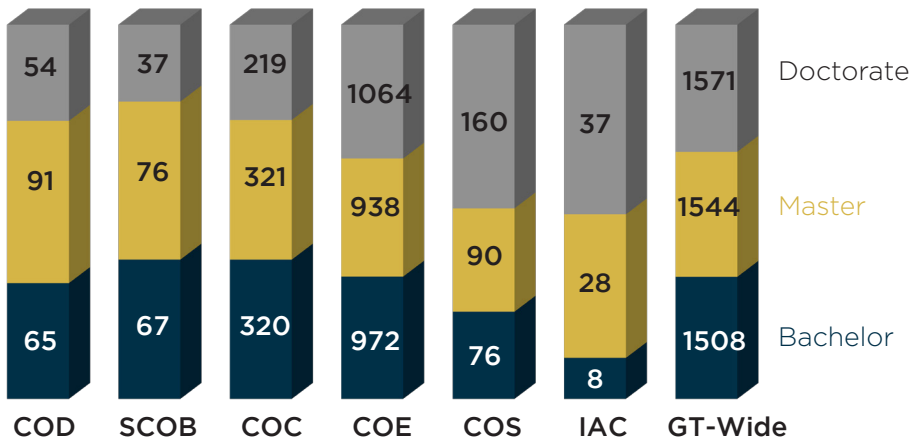
